



## Guidelines for CFHC Scholarships for the 2018-2019 Academic Year

Welcome to Community Foundation of Henderson County's scholarship program. The generosity of donors giving charitable contributions through the Community Foundation make CFHC scholarships possible.

The Scholarship Guidelines offer descriptions of each scholarship being offered by the Community Foundation for the 2018-2019 academic year. Guidance counselors at area schools are a resource for applications as well.

**DEADLINE: Wednesday, January 31, 2018 on or before 5 p.m.**  
**Any application received after the deadline will not be considered.**

**SUBMISSION:**  
**Scholarship submission opens December 1, 2017**  
Complete Online Application at <http://www.cfhcforever.org/scholarships>  
Carefully review all scholarship guidelines as each individual scholarship's criteria differs.  
Only applicants who meet all criteria for a given scholarship will be considered.

**REQUIREMENTS:**  
For scholarship award with financial need criteria, applicants must submit a copy of their completed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) with the completed application to Community Foundation.

A **typed biographical statement of 500-600 words in Times New Roman font** explaining an applicant's educational goals, qualifications and/or financial need is **required**. Applicants should give this special attention as the scholarship committee reviews biographical statements carefully.

*Some scholarships require that applicants submit additional information. Read the application form carefully to see if a particular scholarship(s) being applied for requires additional documentation.*

**TIPS:**  
\*If you complete the application on a computer or similar device, save your work both as you go and once you are finished. To save your work, you will need Adobe Reader, which is free software that allows users to work interactively with PDF files. You can download the latest version of Adobe Reader for free at <http://get.adobe.com/reader/>.

Particular CFHC scholarships are offered each year depending on the availability of funding. Only the scholarships listed in these guidelines are available for the 2018-2019 academic year. **Unless otherwise stated, successful scholarship recipients may re-apply for their scholarship award for up to three subsequent years, as long as funds are available.**

You are encouraged to explore as many different scholarship resources as possible. Guidance counselors are a resource for opportunities. **AMERICAN LEGION, Post 77, Hubert M. Smith Scholarship****\$1,250 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter or stepchild of a current member in good standing for 12 months prior to the scholarship deadline, or of a deceased member in good standing at the time of his death, of Hubert M. Smith, Post 77, American Legion. The applicant must be age 23 or less at the time of the application and be a graduating senior or graduate of a public, parochial or private school who intends to enroll in a two-year or four-year degree granting program. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**William C. ARMSTRONG Scholarship****\$1,500**

The recipient shall be a citizen and resident of Henderson County and shall have graduated from a high school in Henderson County. The applicant must need financial assistance to attend a post-high school institution. The applicant will be committed to the purposes of conservation and preservation of wildlife and the pursuit of a course of study in wildlife management and related sciences and disciplines.

**Dan BARBER/Western Auto Scholarship****\$500 - 1 year only**

Each Henderson County Public High School may nominate one male and one female graduating senior. The nominee must have played and lettered in three varsity sports for two or more years during grades 9-12 (one of those years being their senior year). The nominee must have a GPA of 3.0 or better. Financial need is not a requirement.

**Denis BARTON Scholarship****\$3,000**

The applicant must be a resident of either Transylvania County or Henderson County who has graduated from a public, private, parochial or home school program who wishes to pursue an undergraduate degree at a degree granting college or university and who demonstrates the need for financial assistance in order to attend an institution of higher learning. The applicant should have a cumulative GPA equivalent to a "C average" upon graduation. Preference will be given to students from Transylvania County. Financial need will be more strongly considered than grades. An adult student will be considered for this scholarship if he or she can demonstrate reason as to why he or she did not pursue his or her college education immediately after high school. Such reasons would include but are not limited to military service, medical reasons, family obligations, and/or mission work. The recipient must be awarded the scholarship prior to the age of 30.

**David H. and Betty R. BUCHER ENGINEERING Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The recipient must be a graduating senior of any Henderson County public, private or parochial high school seeking to further his or her education beyond high school. The recipient must be accepted to an accredited degree-granting college or university and be actively pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in the field of engineering. The applicant should have a minimum grade point average of 3.5 or better and should be involved in extracurricular as well as community activities.

**David H. and Betty R. BUCHER NURSING Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is to provide financial support to graduating seniors of any Henderson County public, private or parochial high school seeking to further their education beyond high school. Recipients of this scholarship must be accepted to an accredited degree-granting college or university and be actively pursuing a Bachelor of Science degree in the field of nursing. The applicant should be involved in extracurricular as well as community activities.

**BUSINESS & PROFESSIONAL Women's Club****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior from a school in Henderson County and show strong academic standing with a GPA of 3.0 or better and demonstrate financial need. Students must be pursuing their undergraduate education in a two- or four-year accredited institution.

**Maggie Trimble COOK****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is to provide financial assistance for a deserving girl who needs financial assistance to attend college to prepare for a career in nursing, home economics, or math.

**Amy Duryee COURTENAY Scholarship****\$750**

This scholarship is for a student graduating from either public or private secondary high school in Henderson County who wishes to study nursing or the nursing sciences or medically technical support skills and technologies related to hospital procedures. The recipient must graduate in the top 50% of his or her high school class.

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

**Gregory Stephen Wright The "CROSSROADS" Scholarship** **\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant should attend Hendersonville High School and be overcoming a significant and difficult challenge, such as a physical handicap, severe depression, the death of a parent, severe health complication, or having a child while in school and continuing successfully. The applicant also may be someone who faced such a challenge and then came back to school and is succeeding on a second effort. Preference will be given to those who inspire others by overcoming their challenge and who participate in extracurricular activities. **\*\*\*An essay titled "My Crossroad Experience" is required as a part of the application to be co-signed by some significant other person in the applicant's life who has been a part of helping in this life experience.\*\*\***

**Jane and Tom DAVIS Scholarship** **\$1,000**

The applicant must be a graduating senior or graduate of a Henderson County public school and demonstrate financial need. The student must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better who is seeking an education beyond high school to pursue a degree in the health care field.

**Ray V. DUNK Scholarship (ACCOUNTING)** **\$4,000**

This scholarship is for students graduating from high school or the equivalent who are residents of Henderson County and pursuing a bachelor's degree or the equivalent from an accredited educational institution with a focus on accounting. Applicants for this scholarship should be "top students" with high scholastic achievements and a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4 point scale (B or better). Consideration may be given to all-round performance in school, community involvement and extra-curricular activities. Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

**Rita Ildsgaard DUNK Scholarship (MUSIC/PIANO)** **\$4,000**

This scholarship is for students graduating from high school or the equivalent who are residents of Henderson County and pursuing a bachelor's degree or the equivalent from an accredited education institution with a focus in music having preference given to piano. Recipient should be seeking a career in piano performance and a desire to instruct others in piano. Applicants for this scholarship should be "top students" with high scholastic achievements and a grade point average of 3.0 or better on a 4 point scale (B or better). Consideration may be given to all-round performance in school, community involvement and extra-curricular activities. Applicants must demonstrate financial need.

**Robert and Vivian EDWARDS Scholarship** **\$1,000 – 1 year only**

This scholarship is for a graduate of a Henderson County public, private or parochial high school who plans to enter into the field of veterinary medicine or related studies. This scholarship may be utilized for undergraduate and/or post-graduate studies. The recipient must be a legal resident of the United States.

**Robert C. EDWARDS, JR. Memorial Scholarship** **\$1,250 – 1 year only**

This scholarship is to provide financial aid to a deserving student who has a desire and commitment to pursue his or her education.

**Francis H. and Margery T. ESCOTT** **\$1,000**

This scholarship is for a student in need of financial support who is pursuing an education beyond high school. Preference will be given to a student pursuing a career in math or business administration.

**Grace B. ETHEREDGE Scholarship** **\$2,000**

The scholarship recipient should be a student who plans to attend and has been accepted to attend a four-year college. The student should demonstrate scholastic ability (to include a student gifted in the arts), financial need, character, leadership ability, participation in extracurricular activities and demonstrated ability to complete a college education (in order for the scholarship to be renewed, the student must maintain a GPA of 3.0). Other things being equal, preference should be given to scholastic ability.

**Grace B. ETHEREDGE Scholarship for BRCC Students** **\$1,000 – 2 years only**

The scholarship recipient should be a student who plans to attend and has been accepted to attend a four-year college. The student should demonstrate scholastic ability (to include a student gifted in the arts), financial need, character, leadership ability, participation in extracurricular activities and demonstrated ability to complete a college education (in order for the scholarship to be renewed, the student must maintain a GPA of 3.0). Other things being equal, preference should be given to scholastic ability.

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

**Katherine Schneider GETTMAN Scholarship****\$3,000**

This scholarship shall be awarded to individuals with financial need who are pursuing a degree in any medically related field.

**Dr. Hugh and Madge GLEATON Scholarship****\$4,000**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Henderson County public school planning to attend a four-year accredited university within the UNC University System. The successful applicant will be in the top 15% of his or her graduating class and demonstrate financial need by showing he or she requires financial assistance in order to attend a North Carolina state supported institution of higher learning. Preference will be given to students who are pursuing a degree in the arts, education, engineering, the sciences or medicine.

**James P. GREY Scholarship****\$3,000**

The applicant must demonstrate reasonable need; must demonstrate the capacity for pursuing the advanced education; must be a resident of Henderson County; must not have attended public schools in Henderson County beginning not later than the fourth grammar grade continuing through high school; and must be a candidate for graduation from a public high school in Henderson County.

**Arthur R. HILL Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 – 1 year only**

This scholarship is for a college-bound student from a single-parent home. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA, a community service background, must demonstrate financial need, provide two character references, and demonstrate work ethic and ambition.

**Roger & Judy HILL Memorial Football Scholarship for Mack Broutin****\$1,000 – 1 year only**

The recipient shall have graduated from Hendersonville High School and must require financial assistance to pursue his or her education at a college, university, community college, trade school, or other regular course of instruction leading to some recognized post-high school educational degree or certificate. The recipients must have participated in one or more inter-scholastic high school sport(s) during at least the final two years in high school. Preference will be given to the applicant who played football during the final two years in high school. The recipients must show a strong determination to succeed in life despite personal obstacles.

**Joe T. HUNT Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior who has lettered in varsity football. A recipient will be selected from Henderson and/or Jackson Counties in North Carolina. The applicant must demonstrate financial need and merit.

**CHAT JONES Memorial Scholarship****\$500 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is for a resident of Henderson County seeking further education in an accredited degree-granting college or university. The recipient must demonstrate financial challenges to attend an institution of higher learning. The applicant should show promise and be meeting passing grade requirements but may not be in the top of his or her class rank. Consideration will be given to an applicant with special needs connections (either personally or working with).

**ELSIE MABEL JONES Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduate of any Henderson County high school. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. The applicant must be preparing to teach Latin in public secondary schools. If there are no candidates for the teaching of Latin, the scholarship may be given for the study preparatory to the teaching of English. If there are no qualified candidates for the teaching of English, then the awarding of the scholarship may be not be limited in any subject area.

**Anthony KUSHIGIAN Scholarship****\$2,000**

This scholarship is to provide financial support for a needy minority student who wishes to pursue his or her education beyond the high school level.

**Ethel T. and Charles T. LARUS Scholarship****\$2,000**

This scholarship is for needy and worthy students who are Henderson County residents, regardless of where they attend high school. Recipients must reflect a willingness to work, learn, and pursue their education. Recipients must show financial need. A top 15% class rank for the scholarship recipient shall be considered as a general guideline but is not to be used as an absolute qualification requirement when unusual circumstances exist. The scholarship recipient must attend a four-year accredited college or university on a full-time basis.

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

- Mary Evelyn and Harry LAURENT Scholarship** **\$4,000**  
The applicant must be a graduating senior or a graduate of a public or private high school in Henderson and shall graduate in the top 25 percent of his or her graduating high school class. Student must be a candidate for an associate, bachelor, advanced, or professional degree from a fully accredited college, university, technical institute, or community college. Preference is given to a full-time student, but an applicant working toward a degree on a part-time basis will be considered. Although a specific vocational objective is not necessary, the recipient should evidence a clear-cut educational objective in their course of study.
- Helen F. LINDNER Scholarship** **\$2,000**  
The applicants must be male graduating senior from any high school located within the boundary of Henderson County. The successful male applicant will be a student who may not have excelled academically but who has shown promise academically and who indicates a willing spirit to work. The applicant should be someone who has shown diligence above average but who may not have academically achieved above average.
- Peggy LOVVORN Scholarship** **\$1,000**  
This scholarship is for a student who is a graduate of Hendersonville High School. The student must show financial need. The applicant need not be the student with a high scholastic average but instead has shown a willingness and desire to do his or her best under difficult circumstances.
- MARIA'S Scholarship** **\$1,000**  
This scholarship is for a student who is a resident of Henderson County. The recipient should demonstrate their need for financial assistance to attend an accredited college or university.
- Glenn C. MARLOW Scholarship** **\$1,500 - 1 year only**  
This scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating senior of the Henderson County Public Schools who intends to enter a teacher education program. Preference will be given to a West Henderson High School graduate and a student who attended the Glenn C. Marlow Elementary School.
- MATCHING Funds Scholarship** **\$2,000**  
This scholarship provides funds to match the earnings of a college-level student who needs extra assistance to continue his or her studies.
- Duane M. and Margaret D. MCKIBBIN Scholarship** **\$1,500 – 1 year only**  
This scholarship is provided to a student pursuing an education at an accredited institution.
- George F. and Asha W. MCMILLAN Scholarship** **\$1,000**  
This scholarship is to provide financial support to an individual in order for him or her to receive a degree in Christian education or related studies or to advance his or her Christian vocation.
- Lucile V. MEANS Scholarship** **\$1,000**  
This scholarship is for a worthy African-American student with financial need. The student must be a graduate of Hendersonville High School.
- Ralph A. MILLIMAN Scholarship** **\$1,500**  
The applicant must be a resident of Henderson County but the student does not have to attend a Henderson County school. Financial aid is a requirement. The scholarship is not based on merit but is based on need.
- Sam A. MILLS Memorial Scholarship** **\$1,000 - 1 year only**  
The applicant must be a graduate of a Henderson County public high school who is pursuing an undergraduate degree in an accredited school on a full-time basis. The applicant must demonstrate financial need and show scholastic achievement and good citizenship.
- MILLS RIVER Fire Department Scholarship** **\$1,250 - 1 year only**  
The applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter or stepchild of a current member in good standing, or of a deceased member in good standing at time of his death, of the Mills River Fire and Rescue. This scholarship can also be provided for a member in good standing of the Mills River Fire and Rescue who wishes to pursue their education or training. Applicant must be enrolled as a senior in a public, parochial or private school or be a graduate of such school and intend to enroll in a degree-granting program in an accredited school. Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better and SAT scores of 900 or better and must demonstrate involvement in extracurricular activities. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

**Thomas Oliver and Louise Jordan MULCAHY Scholarship****\$6,000**

This scholarship is for a graduate of a high school in Henderson County and shall be awarded based on academic standing and financial need. The recipient need not be at the top of his or her class academically nor at the bottom of his or her class financially.

**Hans and Margo NAGEL Scholarship****\$2,000**

This scholarship provides assistance with education expenses for a citizen and resident of Henderson County who has graduated from a high school in Henderson County. This scholarship is for someone who is doing things to prevent and break the cycle of desperate need and is to act as an incentive for the recipient to do something, primarily in using education, to pull his or her life together and make a better life for himself or herself and the next generation.

**Hilary G. NEIGHBORS Scholarship (GENERAL)****\$1,500**

The applicant must graduate from a Henderson County public school and must be a native of Henderson County. The applicant must also demonstrate financial need. The recipient must make the highest grades as determined by Community Foundation of Henderson County.

**Hilary G. NEIGHBORS Scholarship (MEDICAL)****\$1,000**

The applicant must graduate from a Henderson County public school and must be a native of Henderson County. The applicant must also demonstrate financial need and on be on track for a medically related degree. The recipient must make the highest grades as determined by Community Foundation of Henderson County.

**Helga NIELSEN Scholarship****\$4,000**

The applicant must have received a two-year degree from Blue Ridge Community College and plan to continue his or education at a four-year accredited institution and/or be a graduating senior of any Henderson County High School. Applicant does not have to be a scholastically high achiever or deeply involved in school activities but rather one who strives to do his or her best and who demonstrates financial need.

**PASSAGE to the Future Scholarship****\$1,000**

The applicant must have graduated from a Henderson County public or private high school and attained a GPA of at least a "C" or its equivalent. Applicant may be planning to attend a two-year or a four-year institution. Financial need is a major consideration for this scholarship. The applicant also should be actively involved in their church, be focused and energetic, and have a strong work ethic.

**Rebecca S. POOLE Scholarship****\$2,000**

This educational scholarship is for a Henderson County student pursuing his or her education beyond high school.

**L.B. PRINCE Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of Hendersonville High School, be a citizen of Henderson County, and must demonstrate financial need.

**John Paul RAYWOOD Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is to provide a post-secondary educational scholarship for children of an active, participating Knight of Columbus in good standing or of a deceased member of the Knights of Columbus, Father Joseph Maule Council #8923 of Arden, N.C. This scholarship is to encourage young men to join the Knights of Columbus. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Plato E. REESE Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be an active member of the Junior Fire Brigade or a child or stepchild of an active adult member of the Etowah-Horse Shoe Volunteer Fire and Rescue. Scholarship assistance may be used for the pursuit of a post-secondary education working toward a certificate or degree-granting program. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Vena Case ROBINSON Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of the Henderson County Public Schools who intends to major in Elementary Education. Preference will be given to a student who attended Dana Elementary School.

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

**Odell ROUSE Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship provides scholarship assistance to a deserving student who demonstrates financial need and who plans to pursue an education beyond 12th grade by attending an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning. The recipient of this scholarship must be an active, participating member of the Boys and Girls Club of Henderson County for at least two years. The recipient of this scholarship must be a Henderson County resident for a period of no less than one year at the time of consideration. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Vina L. and Richard C. SAUER Scholarship****\$1,500**

This scholarship is to be awarded to a recipient who is a citizen and resident of Henderson County; is of good moral character; reflects a general willingness to work, learn and pursue his or her education; shows reasonable financial need; and is not necessarily a superior student but who utilizes as fully as reasonable his or her intellectual talents.

**Martha Sales SCHOCH Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicants must be enrolled as a senior in a public, parochial or private school or be a graduate of such school and intend to enroll in a degree-granting program in an accredited college, university, community college or technical school. The applicant must be an active member of Fletcher United Methodist Church for two years prior to applying for this scholarship. The applicant should have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better and SAT scores of 800 or better. The applicant should demonstrate a financial need and should demonstrate involvement in United Methodist activities. The applicant must be of good moral character and reflect a willingness to work, learn, and pursue an education. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Pat SHEPHERD Second Mile Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

Applicant must be a graduating senior who is a member of Pat's School of Dance and Pat's Dance Company taking tap, jazz and ballet with the intent of furthering his or her education. The student applying for this scholarship must have placed dance as a priority and demonstrated motivation and drive in achieving his or her goals. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**Kristen Sue SHETTERLY Memorial Scholarship****\$ 850 – 2 year only**

The scholarship was established by Kristen Sue Shetterly's family and friends for graduates of Hendersonville High School who have an outstanding personality and reflect the compassion, enthusiasm and caring for others which Kristy exhibited. The recipient needs to be in the 25<sup>th</sup> percentile of the class.

**Andrea Davies SKILLMAN Scholarship****\$1,000 – 1 year only**

This scholarship provides financial assistance for a student of West Henderson High School matriculating to higher education at an accredited institution. A student who enters a Pathways Program, Early College Program or a post-secondary school early are also eligible. Students may be a business or marketing major with entrepreneurial goals. The student must exhibit the primary characteristic of having an entrepreneurial spirit and drive to succeed.

**James SMITH Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000**

This scholarship is for students pursuing a higher education in either engineering or Christian education at an accredited college, university, community college or technical school.

**George and Helen STOWELL Scholarship (GENERAL)****\$4,000**

This scholarship is for a graduating senior of any Henderson County public high school who is also a native of Henderson County. The applicant will be chosen based on merit, cumulative GPA of 3.8 or better and SAT scores of 1200 or better.

**George and Helen STOWELL Scholarship (MEDICAL)****\$4,000**

This scholarship is for a graduating senior of any Henderson County public high school who is also a native of Henderson County and is pursuing a career in a health-related field, other than a physician. The applicant will be chosen based on merit, cumulative GPA of 3.8 or better and SAT scores of 1200 or better.

**Kenneth R. and Virginia M. STULL Scholarship****\$3,000**

This scholarship is to assist a worthy student in furthering his or her education beyond the high school level.

**Applications due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, January 31, 2018**

**Russell Boyd THOMAS Scholarship****\$1,500 - 1 year only**

The scholarship is for a graduating senior of Hendersonville High School. The qualifying recipient must be accepted and attend a qualified, degree-granting college or university in pursuit of an academic or professional degree. The recipient must demonstrate and maintain reasonable academic standards to continue his or her chosen course of study leading to a degree at their selected institution of higher learning. The award is meant for a student of low- to middle-income, well-rounded in character, morality, leadership and other factors of such general nature which would indicate the recipient would be a worthy candidate. The candidate will have participated in the Hendersonville High School band. A preference should be given but not required if none are available in any given academic year for a student with some form of medical complication. A preference also may be given to a student wishing to pursue a degree in science or the medical field.

**Robert B. TONJES Scholarship****\$1,000**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of a Henderson County public high school or the equivalent who is pursuing a four-year degree in nursing or other medical related fields. Applicant must demonstrate a financial need by showing he or she requires assistance to attend an institution of higher learning.

**VALLEY CLINIC Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is for candidates pursuing a degree in the health care field who demonstrate financial need and academic merit. The applicant must be a full-time resident of the Hickory Nut Gorge community.

**VFW Hedrick Rhodes Post 5206 Scholarship****\$1,000**

The applicant must be the son, daughter, grandson, granddaughter or stepchild of a current member in good standing, or of a deceased member in good standing at time of his death, of Veterans of Foreign Wars, Post 5206. The applicant must be enrolled as a senior in a public, parochial, or private school or be a graduate of such school and intend to enroll in a degree-granting program at an accredited school. The applicant must be age 23 or less at time of application. **\*\*You must submit a letter from the organization's leadership verifying that you meet criteria\*\***

**DR. CORBIN O. WILLIAMS Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of Hendersonville High School or the equivalent who has been accepted to and plans to attend the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The applicant should demonstrate high academic standards, leadership abilities and exhibit high levels of interpersonal compatibility.

**JOHN BROOKS WILLIAMS Scholarship****\$1,000 - 2 years only**

The applicant must be a graduating senior of Hendersonville High School who demonstrates a financial need by showing he or she requires some assistance or is otherwise helping the family fulfill their financial obligations. In addition, the scholarship recipient shall be a person who has shown academic potential, has demonstrated personal motivation and has set goals for his or her future. The student should have a cumulative, unweighted GPA of at least 2.0 but no higher than 3.5.

**LULA AND LEVI WILSON Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship is for an African-American student with financial need who wishes to pursue his or her education.

**TOM WILSON Scholarship****\$1,000 - 1 year only**

This scholarship was established by the previous Hendersonville City Schools Board of Education in honor of Mr. Wilson for his commitment and dedication to the students of Hendersonville High School and is for a deserving student who is a graduate of Hendersonville High School.

**John P. and Mary Ann WOLD Scholarship****\$2,000 - 2 years only**

The scholarship is to provide financial support to a student seeking to further his or her education beyond high school and who wishes to pursue a degree in the fields of science, technology, engineering, math, or health care at Blue Ridge Community College. The recipients must demonstrate financial need, be a resident of Henderson County and maintain a minimum 2.75 GPA. Non-traditional students are encouraged to apply.

**Winifred M. WYMAN Memorial Scholarship****\$1,000**

The applicant must be a graduate of a Henderson County public school who wishes to pursue his or her education at an accredited college or university. The recipient must have a B- or better grade point average and have shown academic potential and motivation and have set goals for his or her future.
